1. Organization Information

Brief summary of organization history

A. The Women's Cabinet/Community Cabinet was originally established in May 1998, by a retired Art Teacher John Iacovelli & his daughter Angaela Iacovelli. Non-profit status was granted in April 2002, with the final approval of 501 (C)(3) status letter dated October 26, 2006. Hygiene products are not covered by Food Stamps or other public assistance programs, thus creating a need for the services our organization provides. The Community Cabinet is volunteer run. Every year, we collect hygiene products from donation bins, civic organizations and individuals and process them to be redistributed to many human service agencies.

Our mission has been to meet the essential, but not often thought of, lack of access to hygiene products for people in need. We educate the general public and supply agencies with kits for their clients. Our goal is to increase self-esteem, promote better health, and open doors toward a more purposeful life for people in need.

Our organization is a socio-economic agency dedicated to promoting better health and well-being through the provision of hygiene products. We deliver these products to our community's less fortunate individuals, dialysis and amputee patients, veterans, homeless and families directly and/or through social and non-profit agencies who distribute them to their clients on our behalf, providing hygiene education along the way.

The Community Cabinet serves the Truckee Meadows Great Basin area. We serve Washoe County, Lyon County, Storey County, and Douglas County when possible.
